### **Kelleys Rocks!**

**Monday August 3**

**Meet at the Glacial Grooves**

Geologists XXX and XXX join Kelleys Island State Park Manager Chris Ashley to lead explorers on a hike through one of Ohio's most geologically interesting state parks. Learn how the world-famous glacial grooves were shaped by both ancient bedrock geology and more recent Ice Age glaciers, as well as the construction of the Stone Building that was used for.... We will hike to the alvar, and there will also be a search for fossils in the bedrock.

Have you seen Saturn's Rings? How about Jupiter's Moons? Join research astronomer Jay Reynolds, of Cleveland State University, as he provides telescopes and views of the planets, star clusters and even a 'coat hanger'. Binoculars and instruction of how to view other items will be provided. In the event of clouds, there will be a short program and meteorite touch lab. Each participant will receive a planisphere!

### **South Bass Island Ecotour**

**Thursday August 6**

**Meet at the Jet Express Dock**

Come enjoy South Bass Island's history and natural history for the day! All transportation, lunch, and private guided tours are bundled into one economically friendly price, that benefits Kelleys Island's youth Nature Camps. We will board the Jet Express from Kelleys Island at 9:55AM. The six-mile ferry boat ride west, takes around 30 minutes to Downtown Put-in-Bay. We will start by going to Perry's Victory and International Peace Memorial. This 352-foot monument commemorates the Battle of Lake Erie, won by the Americans led by Oliver Hazard Perry who defeated the British. We will then travel through town, to the Goat for lunch. The Goat is located near the quiet Coopers Woods and Heineman Winery. The Goat is family owned by the Jackson Family, they specialize in using locally grown sustainable food, and it is always fresh! Once our bellies are just filled enough, we will walk through Coopers Woods a short distance to Heineman Winery for a private tour of the winery and crystal cave, followed by a token for a taste of one of their wines or juice. We will then travel around the west shore of South Bass Island to Ohio State University's Stone Laboratory for a private tour of the historic fish hatchery/Aquatic Visitor Center, and Gibraltar Island! We will travel to the Island by one of the water taxis located in the harbor of Put-in-Bay. Once we leave Gibraltar Island, we will have some time to tour around downtown on your own before coming back to Kelleys Island.

### **Kayaking 101**

Providing busy adults an all-too-rare opportunity to re-set, re-charge and re-discover belonging, strength and purpose, this course explores the sandy beaches, alvar, and aquatic plants and wildlife of Kelleys Island shore in Lake Erie.
